**Bug Type:** Functional

**Frequency:** Everytime

**Severity:** High (Affects sharing site to Twitter every time)

**Actions Performed:**

1. Go to URL <http://www.dh.gov.uk/health/2012/09/stoptober>
2. Go to the Share: section further down page. (See screenshot #1)
3. Select Tweet option.
4. The screen 'Share a link with your followers' appears so you can Tweet your message.
5. The message text displayed is "Stoptober campaign will encourage smokers to quit for 28 days <http://www.wp.dh.gov.uk/health/2012/09/stoptober/>" (See screenshot #2)

**Expected Results:** The correct URL to be included in the message text.




**Actual Result:** An incorrect URL is included in the message text.
